bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Annie W
Earle all that lot of land in the City of Greenville in the
County of Greenville in the State aforesaid on the north
west corner of West and Whitner Streets, containing one
half acre, more or less, adjoining lot of Mrs Spears and
others having a front of one hundred and nine feet on
West Street, and two hundred feet on Whitner Street being
the same lot of land conveyed by Mrs Spears to Roseme
and and by Roseme to J. W. Westmoreland, and by West-
moreland to Dr. Thos J Earle and by Earle to his wife
Sallie F Earle and by the said Sallie F Earle to me
