Whereas Mrs Harriet B
McBee of Greenville

County in said State, did on the first day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy two, as Guardian for her children, sell and convey to one Rodolphus H. Gossett of said State and County a certain piece parcel and lot of land situate lying and being on Echols Street in the City and County of Greenville and State aforesaid, containing nine tenths of an acre more or less and particularly described in the deed therefor to the said Rodolphus H. Gossett which is recorded in Book D. D. ^{p. 666} of the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance for said State and County And whereas, by virtue of an order of the Honorable James L. Orr dated the twenty eighth day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy two, confirming the aforesaid Deed among others, and authorizing the said Mrs Harriet B. McBee as Guardian as aforesaid, to sell and convey other lands, the said Mrs Harriet B. McBee as Guardian as aforesaid, did on the nineteenth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy four sell and convey to one Mrs L. M. Gossett a certain other piece parcel and lot of land situate lying and being on the West side of Echols Street in the City, County and State aforesaid, containing four tenths of an acre more or less and particularly described in a deed therefor to the said Mrs L. M. Gossett which is recorded in Book F. F. of the Register of Mesne Conveyance aforesaid and whereas there is some doubt whether the interest of those of the children of the said Mrs Harriet B. McBee, who were of legal age at the dates of the before mentioned deeds and of the orders aforesaid have been all mine by these presents that we Frank B. McBee and Vandy E.
