T M Shackleton and others beginning at a R O Stump thence N 8 1/2 W 61
50 to a chestnut stump thence N 22 E 20 24 to a W O Stump thence
S 28 1/2 E 9 to a stake 3 x thence S 74 1/2 E 20 75 to a stake 3 x thence S 74 1/2 W 18
to a stake 3 x S 71 1/2 E 6 13 to a stake 3 x thence E 15 1/2 W 26 22 to a branch
thence along said Branch Durban Creek thence along said branch to
