Deed

Whereas an order was passed by  
Chancellor Wm D Johnson in the  
case entitled "Ex Parte the Commr  
in the matter of E A Belue (Belue

Trust" at the June term of the Court of Equity, held for the District  
Court County of Spartanburg in the year 1868 requiring me to declare  
upon the within deed that four hundred & fifty Dollars of the purchase  
money of the tract of land therein described were monies of the  
trust estate of E A Belue held by me in trust for the said E A Belue  
and that to that extent I stand seized of said premises as trustee  
of said E A Belue Now therefore I do hereby declare unto all  
whom it may concern that four hundred and fifty dollars  
of the purchase money of the within described tract of land  
paid by me to Wm Elford were monies arising from the sale  
of fifty two acres of land more or less situated in Spartanburg
