Glenn all that certain piece parcel and tract of land lying and being in Greenville County and State aforesaid on the Lawrence road, leading from Greenville to Lawrence Court House about nine and a half miles from Greenville adjoining lands of Thomas Gorrell and Mahaley Fowler and others containing forty (40) acres more or less

Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in any wise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said G. S. Glenn his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said G. S. Glenn his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim the same or any part thereof,
