Budduth of Greenville County, in the state aforesaid have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said D. J. Budduth her heirs and assigns forever all that lot or parcel of land, situate lying and being in the County and State aforesaid on Gaith Fogger River bounded by lands of Julia Glazier, Rubin Budduth and Manley Bright containing twenty acres being the upper part of the tract purchased by me of Solomon Drill

together with all and singular the rights, meadows, hereditaments and appurtenances, to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said D. J. Budduth her heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said

premises, unto the said D. J. Budduth her heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and every other person whomever lawfully claiming, or to claim the same or any part thereof.
