Henderson's lot and on the South by Washington Street Together with all and singular the rights mem- bers, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining, To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said George Putnam his heirs and assigns forever, and also hereby bind my heirs executors and administrators to warrant & forever defend all and singular the said premises, unto the said George Putnam his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim the same or any part thereof Witness my hand and seal this first day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy seven and in the one hundred and one st year of the Independence of the United States of America.
