

June A.D. 1874, it was referred to a special Referee, to report on the various matters embraced in the pleadings in said cause, and upon the report of said special Referee coming in, containing the various recommendations therein more fully set forth, it was on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of August A.D. 1874 amongst other things, ordered that Whetner Dymmes and Thomas le Gower, be appointed Trustees, to whom William A. McDowell Clerk of the said court, should convey the said lands, to have and to hold the same, to, for and upon the purposes, uses and trusts as set forth and declared in the Deeds reported by the said Referee; and whereaz, the said William A. McDowell Clerk, as aforesaid, did convey the lands mentioned in the pleadings to the said Trustees, Now therefore, know all men by these presents, that we Thomas le Gower and Whetner Dymmes Trustees as aforesaid, by virtue of the power conferred upon us, in and by the order and trust Deed aforesaid, upon the written request of the estates give trust hereunder endorsed, and in performance of our duty as such trustees and also in consideration of the sum of Two hundred and twenty four  $\frac{1}{16}$  Dollars to us paid by the Mechanics Building and Loan Association of Greenville County before the delivery of these presents, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Mechanics Building and Loan Association of Greenville County all that piece, parcel or lot of land being parcels of the lands above mentioned, situate and lying in the City of Greenville in the County and State aforesaid beginning at a Stake on Gower Street running thence S 70 $\frac{1}{2}$  E sixty three feet to a stake, thence S 21 $\frac{1}{2}$  E two hundred and fifty one feet and one half of one foot to stake thence N 74 $\frac{1}{2}$  W three hundred and fifty eight feet and one half of one foot to stake on street, thence N 28 $\frac{1}{2}$  E two hundred and eighty four feet to a stake on Gower Street thence along said street S 61 $\frac{1}{2}$  E two hundred and five feet to the beginning point containing one acre and one rod and thirty three perches more or less. Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances, to the said premises belonging, or in any wise incident or appertaining, To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said Mechanics Building and Loan Association of Greenville County their successors, heirs and assigns forever freed from and discharged of all further trusts whatsoever and we do hereby bind ourselves, and his executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular the said premises unto the said Mechanics Building and Loan Association of Greenville County their successors and assigns against us, and our heirs and every other person whatsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim the same or any part thereof by, through and under us as trustees aforesaid.
