aforesaid (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have  
granted, bargained sold and released and by these presents  
do grant bargain sell and release unto the said L. J. Jennings  
a tract piece or parcel of land lying and being situate in Greenv-  
ille County in the State aforesaid on the west side of the State Road  
and north side of the Tugaloo Road containing thirty and one  
half (30 1/2) acres more or less and is part of the James McKim-  
ney tract of land and runs as follows Beginning at a stake  
3x in the Tugaloo Road Daniel McKimney's 3x thence N 25 1/2  
W 16.70 chains to a stake 3x Wm McKimney's 3x thence S 74 1/2 E 15.75  
chains to stake 3x thence East 4.50 chains to a stake 3x in the  
centre of the State Road thence along the said State Road 19.81  
chains to a stake 3x in the center and crossing of the State and  
Tugaloo Roads thence along the said Tugaloo Road 15.29 chains  
to the beginning Stake 3x bounded by lands of L. J. Jennings
