To
Mrs. S. F. Boag
Know all men by these presents,
that I William W. Miller of New-
berry, County in the State of or said for and in consideration of the
love and affection I bear for Mrs. Ballie F. Boag, my sister, also for
and in consideration of the sum of Five dollars to me paid by
the said Ballie F. Boag a citizen of the County of Greenville in
the State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released
and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto
the said Ballie F. Boag all that piece parcel and lot of land
situate lying and being on the corner of Buoncombel and Duncan
streets, in the City of Greenville, in the State aforesaid and
having the following metes and bounds to wit: running on Buoncombel
Street on the North One hundred and three and one fourth feet
on Dunkin Street on the West two hundred and three feet, on
the South, on the lot of J. H. Latimer thirty five feet, and on
said lot on the East Sixty three feet the lot aforesaid
and hereby conveyed, is a life estate to the said Ballie F. Boag
for and during her natural life at the death of the said Ballie
(F. Boag) the said lot of land shall revert in fee simple in her
son, William Miller Boag; but should the said William Miller
Boag die prior to his mother, the said Ballie F. Boag then and in
that case, the said lot at the death of the said Ballie F. Boag
shall revert and vest in fee simple in the heirs of the body of the
said Ballie F. Boag then living if any then should be and in
case the said Ballie F. Boag should die childless and without
any issue of her body then living, then and in that case
the said lot of land shall revert in fee simple and revert to the
grantor hereof, the said William W. Miller. The land above
conveyed is the same lot that was conveyed to me by A. B.
Duncan by Deed bearing date 1st January 1873 and recorded
in the office of the Register of Deeds conveyance for said
Greenville County in Deed Book E.E. page 257
Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments
and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any
wise incident or appertaining, to have and to hold all and
singular the premises before mentioned unto the said
Ballie F. Boag in and under the condition above stated her
heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself, my
heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever
defend, all and singular the said premises unto the said
Ballie F. Boag in and under the conditions above stated her
heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and all
persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or claiming the same.
