 South Carolina (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted
 bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain
 sell and release unto the said Mrs. M. Alice Brown all that
 certain piece and parcel of land situate lying and being in the
 City of Greenville in the State of South Carolina containing three four-
 ths of an acre more or less; Beginning at a stake on the
 South side of Washington Street, adjoining the Rail Road pur-
 chase, thence S 4 E Ninety eight feet to a stake, thence S 5 1/2
 W two hundred and twenty three feet to a stake, corner of lands
 of John Westfield deceased, thence S 50 E Seventy two and
