

thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining and the reversions and reversions, remainders and remainders, rents issues and profits thereof, and also all the estate right title interest, property, possession claim and demand whatsoever, as well at law as in equity, of the said party of the first part, of, in or to the above described premises, and every part and parcel thereof, with the appurtenances, To have and to hold, all and singular the above mentioned and described premises and property, together with the appurtenances, unto the said Elizabeth Durumham and Henry O Hammitt their successors and assigns, in trust and for the several uses, intents and purposes hereinafter mentioned namely first, in trust to lease the same, and to take collect and receive, the rents issues and profits thereof, and out of the same to keep the said premises in good order and repair pay all taxes, assessments, and charges, that may be imposed thereon second, in trust, to pay the residue of such rents, issues, and income to my daughters Nancy L Stone and L N Stone's maintainances to the intent and purpose that they may enjoy possess, and have the same free from the control of any person during the term of their minority thirdly, intent, that when they Nancy L Stone and L N Stone becomes to the age of twenty one, the said trust shall cease and determine, and the land and premises above described, shall belong in fee simple absolute to said Nancy L Stone and L N Stone and to their heirs and their sole use and benefit and behoof, forever, and the said parties of the second part doth hereby signifying their acceptance of this trust, and doth hereby covenant and agree to and with the said party of the first part faithfully to discharge and execute the same according to the true intent and meaning of these presents.
