Harrison in the State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred and forty six dollars to me in hand paid by Jonathan Gary in the State aforesaid, I have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Jonathan Gary all that tract or parcel of land lying being and situated in the District and State aforesaid on Raburns Creek waters of Reedy River being bounded and defined as follows beginning at Pine 3 x running N 88 W 21.75 to maple 3 x thence N 23 1/2 E 17.75 to Black Oak 3 x at Wilsons Bridge Road along said Road 15.50 to a stake 3 x thence S 10 E 7 to Red Oak 3 x thence S 68 1/2 E 7.50 to stake 0 x thence S 7 E 13.50 to the beginning corner containing forty nine and a quarter acres be the same more or less Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Jonathan Gary his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Jonathan Gary or his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
