of Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, have granted bargained  
sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain  
sell and release, unto the said A. W. Holliday all that tract or par-  
cel of land containing One hundred and thirty one Acres (be the  
same more or less) situate in State and County aforesaid lying on  
and near Saluda River it being a part of the Pollock & Morris  
Tracts of land, Beginning on a stone 3x on Saluda River thence N  
89 E 57, 25 to a stone 3x thence N 89 1/2 E 17, 10 to a Pine 3x dead thence  
N 38, E 11, 05 to the Road and stone 3x thence N 27 W 21, 50 the road  
the line to a stone 3x thence S 65 E 75, 00 to a stone 3x thence S 17  
W 8, 00 to the beginning corner bounded by lands belonging to  
James Holliday all other sides by lands Mrs. A. M. Stokes
