I Perry D Gilbreath of the County of Greenville in the Said State, send
Greeting, whereas Alexander M. Bee, of the County of Greenville
and State aforesaid Plaintiff on or about the third day of February
in the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy seven did
exhibit his Complaint in the Court of Common Pleas in the County
of Greenville and State aforesaid, against Elizabeth Fowler Lawrence
& Fowler Thomas A Fowler Nancy E Fowler and Madora E Fowler
all of Greenville County and State aforesaid, Defendants, for the
foreclosure of a mortgage executed on the twenty first day of Sep-
tember A.D 1875 by S L Fowler Trustee to the said Alexander
M. Bee on a tract of land hereinafter described, and the cause being
an issue before the Honorable Court aforesaid, came on to be heard
on the twenty second day of March One thousand eight hundred
and seventy seven when the said Court, after a full hearing
thereof, and mature deliberation in the premises, Did order, adjudge
and Decree that the tracts of land hereinafter mentioned and descri-
bed, should be sold at Public Auction, by the Sheriff of Greenvi-
lle County, on the terms and for the purposes mentioned in said
Decretal Order, as by reference thereto, on file in the said court,
will appear; and the said Perry D Gilbreath Sheriff as aforesaid
after having duly advertised the said tract of Land for
sale by public outcry, on the fourth day of February in the year
of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and Seventy eight
Did then, openly and publicly, and according to the custom of auc-
tion, sell and dispose of the said tract of land below descri-
bed, unto Henry J Stroud and Samuel B Hutchings of the
County of Greenville and State aforesaid for Five hundred and
Twenty Dollars, they being, at that price, the highest bidder
for the same, Now know all men, that I the said Perry D
Gilbreath Sheriff as aforesaid in consideration of the premises, and
also in consideration of the sum of Five hundred and Twenty dollars
paid me by the said Henry J Stroud & Saml B Hutchings the
receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained
sold and released and by these presents do grant, bargain
sell and release unto the said Henry J Stroud & Samuel B
Hutchings and their heirs and assigns all the lands and tenem-
ents situated in the County of Greenville and State aforesaid
lying and being on the waters of Rockey Creek and Enoree
River, bounded on the west by lands of S L Fowler and S
B Hutchings, on the north by lands of the Batesville
Manufacturing Company and on the East and South by
lands of the estate of John and Manning Mahaffey, con-
taining two hundred acres more or less, being a part of
the tract of land I know as the Richardson place and
conveyed in the trust deed of P. L Lester, and in addition
thereto fifty acres of land known as the Major Miss
