acres more or less lying and being in State and County aforesaid
on the branch waters of Durbin's Creek bounded by W. H.
Stewart, R. H. Vaughan and others Beginning at a P. O. stump
thence S 5° 7' 1/2 W 13, 25 to stone & thence S 79 E 14.50 to Chestnut & 3
thence N 61 W 23.50 W. 0. 85. on Branch thence the meanders of
Branch 36.50 ch to maple thence b 12 E 12.75 to Stone 3 & thence
S 78 E 11.80 to Stone 8 & thence N 49 E 8.10 to Stone 3 & thence 87.7
E 11.80 to Stone 3 & thence N 18 E 19.50 to the beginning corner
Together with all and singular the rights, members, heredit-
aments, appurtenances belonging or in any wise incident thereto
to the said premises. To have and to hold the above described
premises unto the said L. P. Stewart his heirs and assigns
forever and I hereby bind myself my heirs executors &
Administrators to warrant and forever defend the same
