 have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these presents  
 do grant bargain, sell and release unto the said Middleton Brooks  
 a tract piece or parcel of land lying and being situate in Green-  
 ville County and State aforesaid containing seven and one fifth  
 acres more or less, and is part of a tract conveyed to me by James  
 M Ransom County Auditor of Greenville County South Carolina  
 the 18<sup>th</sup> day of Sept 1874 and more as follows beginning on  
 a stone 3x on side of mill road thence S 76 1/4 E 7.60 chains  
 to a stone 3x thence N 73 3/4 E 13.43 chains to a stake 3x Spanish  
 Oak gone thence S 56 1/8 W 11.55 chains to a stone 3x on side of  
 mill road thence S 10 1/4 W 4.96 chains to the beginning stone corner  
 bounded by lands of Dorcas Dill Mrs Norton and Mrs Nelson  
 Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditam-  
 ents and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in  
 anywise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all by  
 singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Middleton
