bidder at the sum above mentioned

singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances
to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or app-
ertaining To have and to hold, all and singular the premises
before mentioned, unto the said R. H. Earle his heirs and
assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs execu-
tors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all
singular the said premises unto the said R. H. Earle his heirs
and assigns, against me and my heirs and every other
person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the
same or any part thereof
