L. Fowler and S. B. Hutchings on the North by lands of the Oatesville Manufacturing Company and on the East and South by lands of the Estate of John and Manning Mahaffey containing two hundred acres more or less being a part of the tract of land known as the Richardson place and conveyed in the Trust deed of P. L. Lester and in addition thereto fifty acres of land known as the paper mill tract which was bought at Sheriff's sale by Thomas L. Fowler deceased on the seventh day of October A. D. 1872 Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Elizabeth Fowler and her heirs and assigns forever and we do hereby bind ourselves and our heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Elizabeth Fowler and her heirs and assigns against ourselves and our heirs
