Hunter Commissioners of Cherokee County in the State of Georgia greeting: I know ye that in consideration of your integrity and skillful power is hereby given to you To take the renunciation of Mrs. S. A. Edwards wife of Edward Edwards of Cherokee County in the State of Georgia of her dower in the premises described in the deed from the said Edward Edwards to Hamilton Hawthorn & Edward Brown dated at Greenville S. C. the 14th day of June 1878 conveyed as certain lot of land situate in the County of Greenville in the State of South Carolina which is described in the annexed deed for this purpose you will cause the said Mrs. S. A. Edwards to appear before you and you will examine her privately and separately and apart from all other persons, and if upon such examination she shall freely declare that she does freely voluntarily and without any compulsion dread or fear of any person or persons whom soever renounce release and forever relinquish to Hamilton Hawthorn & Edward Brown their heirs and assigns all her interest and estate and also all her right and claim of Dower of in or to all and singular the premises described and conveyed in the deed aforesaid Then you shall take under her hand a certificate of her renunciation as aforesaid in the form of a declaration upon private examination as aforesaid which certificate authenticated by your hands and seals you shall annex to this writ and having certified under your hands and seals the execution of this writ and verified the same by the oath of one of you before some magistrate who is authorized by the laws of your state to administer an oath and whose official signature may be properly authenticated you shall carefully return this writ together with your proceedings thereon to the Clerk of the Court of Common Pleas and General Sessions for Greenville County in the State first aforesaid to be duly recorded herein fail not.
