 sum of Six hundred Dollars to us paid by John Purdine
 of the City and County of Greenville in the State aforesaid
 have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents
 do grant bargain sell and release unto the said John Purdine all
 that piece parcel and tract of land situate lying and being in
 the County and State aforesaid, on Long Branch, waters of Reedy
 River two and one half miles South West of the City of Greenville,
 during his natural life and after his death to the children of
 Adeline Byrd deceased, to remain the property of the said
 children until the youngest child reaches her majority, cont-
 aining fifty acres more or less beginning at a Post Oak corner
 97 and running thence N 65 W 28.18 to a stake 97 thence S 46 1/2 W
 14.75 to a Post Oak 97, thence S 42 1/4 E 20.60 to a Stone 97, thence
 N 58 E 27.10 to the beginning corner, bounded by lands of S. L.
 Gower and W. J. Shumate, also lots Nos 5 and 7 of the above and
