the State aforesaid (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged)  
have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents  
do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Mrs L. F.  
M. Daniel all my right title and interest being the undivided one  
third part thereof in the following lands to have and to hold  
my said interest unto her the said Mrs L. F. M. Daniel in all that  
piece parcel and tract of land situate lying and being in Greenwell  
County South Carolina containing One hundred and eleven  
acres two rods and thirty five rods more or less and having  
the following lines metes and bounds to wit: beginning at a
