Know all men by these presents that I Jacob Pruitt of the State and County aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by Harris Pitman of the same State and County aforesaid have granted bargained sold and conveyed and by these presents do grant bargain sell and convey unto the Harris Pitman his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Greenville and State aforesaid adjoining lands of John Woodwin Edward Turner Charles Roswell commencing on a rock corner on the original line of the Portmans Howard old tract on top of the burnt mountain thence a conditional between Jacob Pruitt and Harris Pitman thence nearly so to the mouth the branch near Mat Phillips old house then nearly so to the top of the red deer mountain to lead over the creek and nearly so thence a strait line towards Deans Mary House to John H. Woodwin line containing two hundred and ninety acres more or less Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging

or in any wise incident or appertaining.
