Now therefore we the said Benjamin M Winstock and Waddy L Owings, partners as aforesaid, in consideration of the premises, and of one dollar to us paid by William L Mauldin of said city, County and State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted bargained sold assigned and transferred, and by these presents do grant bargain sell, assign, transfer and deliver unto the said William L Mauldin all of our stock of dry goods, shoes, clothing, notions and other goods, wares and merchandise, with all of our notes, accounts and other choses in action, belonging to us the said Winstock & Owings, to have and to hold the same unto the said W. L. Mauldin, in trust to sell and dispose of said stock, and to collect said rights of action, with power to compound for said rights of action, taking a part for the whole where the said William L Mauldin shall deem it expedient so to do: and then in trust to apply the proceeds of said property and rights of action as follows:

1. To pay Earle & Wells attorneys at law the sum of Fifty Dollars for Counsel, advice and legal services, and to pay the lawful expenses of executing the trusts hereby created.
 2. To pay our Clerk Austin Garrett the sum of one hundred and fifty Dollars and our Clerk J H Winstock the sum of Two hundred and fifty Dollars.
 3. To distribute the remainder of said proceeds in payment of the debts of us the said Winstock & Owings; provided however that if there shall not be sufficient funds with which to pay all of said debts in this clause mentioned, then the said debts are to be paid ratably and in proportion; and provided further that any creditor accepting the benefits of this assignment shall forever discharge us from their respective debts.
 4. The residue of said proceeds if any, the said William L Mauldin is to pay to us the said Winstock & Owings: the survivor of us, our executors, administrators or assigns.
