and State aforesaid known as the mill tract of the Estate of W P Rice  
Beginning at a Poplar on creek thence S 54 1/4 W 21 86 to a stone 3x  
thence N 34 1/2 W 10.70 to a stone 3x thence N 47 1/2 E 14.00 to a stone 3x  
thence S 87 1/2 E 9.86 to stone over the road thence S 32 1/4 E 6.95 to  
the Beginning corner Poplar on creek below the mill containing  
Twenty four acres more or less. Together with all and singular the  
rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises  
belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. To have and to  
hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said
