sell and release unto the said Mathias Roberts, a part of a certain tract
of land containing twenty acres more or less it being a part of the
Turner P. Mill place situated in Oak Lawn Township Greenville
County & State aforesaid, on the waters of Mountain Creek, bounded
by lands belonging to, G. Chapman, Mathias Roberts and others, begin-
ning on stone on Chapman line S 9 W 8.00 to a maple in front of bran-
ch thence the meanderings of said branch or creek to a Hickory &
thence due west 3.75 to a stone & thence N 29 E 8.00 to a stone &
thence N 58 W 12.00 to the beginning corner. Together with
all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appertinances
to the said premises, belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining
to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto
the said Mathias Roberts his heirs executors administrators and assigns
to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises
