G. W. Goodwin sold and conveyed to
one J. W. Holland the tract of land herein after described for the sum of
Dollars and to secure the payment of the purchase money therefor
I having received a deed to the said tract of land executed and delivered
to Geo W. Goodwin a mortgage of the same bearing date April 11th 1874 and
recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds conveyance in the
County aforesaid in Book 6 Page 472: and whereas owing to my
inability to pay the purchase money for the tract of land aforesaid and for
the purpose of rescinding the said sale and conveyance myself and the said
G. W. Goodwin exchanged papers and the said Geo W. Goodwin has since
sold and conveyed the said tract to J. P. Goodwin. Now therefore know
all men by these presents that for the purpose of confirming the title
to the said tract in the said J. P. Goodwin as well as in the consid-
eration of the notes and mortgages delivered to me by G. W. Goodwin, and
in further consideration of one dollar to me paid by the said J. P. Goodwin
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) that I the said J. W. Holland
have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these presents do grant
bargain sell and release unto the said J. P. Goodwin all that piece of land
or tract of land situate lying and being in the State and County aforesaid
on the waters of Horsepen Creek adjoining lands of Alexander
Abercrombie, He Wood, W. T. League and others, and containing two
hundred and twenty three acres more or less. Together with all and singular
the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said
premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining, To
have and to hold all and singular the said premises before mentioned
unto the said J. P. Goodwin his heirs and assigns forever, and I do
hereby bind myself and my heirs executors and administrators to
warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises
unto the said J. P. Goodwin his heirs and assigns against myself
