C. Mark the same being known as lot No two formerly bel-
onging to the estate of Carson, dec'd and being a part of lot
No two of the lands of the late Vandy M. Bee dec'd which
was assigned to the said Mrs Martha A. Carson dec'd in her
life time by the Honorable Court of Equity for Greenville
District now County as a part of her distributive share
of her dec'd father the said Vandy M. Bee the same being
the lot of land conveyed on the fourth day of December A. D
1872 by J. M. Carson, G. A. Carson and J. M. Mason to
Wm S. Sherman > Together with all and singular the rights
members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises

in consideration of the sum of Eighty Dollars to me paid by Belle A Good-
win of the County of Greenville in the State aforsaid, have granted barg-
ained sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and
release unto the said Belle A Goodwin a certain tract piece or parcel of
land in the County and State aforsaid, on some small branches of North
Fork and Middle Saluda River, being the tract of land conveyed to me by
W. C. Goodwin by Deed bearing date 21st December 1871 and runs as follows
i. e. Beginning on a Chestnut 3x on a branch of North Saluda river, thence S
47 1/2 W 16.50 chains to a Oak oak 3x. thence N 19 1/2 W 23.00 chains to a
Chestnut 3x. thence N 29 1/2 W 32.00 chains to a white oak 3x. thence N 67 1/2
E 20.00 chains to a Chestnut 3x. thence S 15 E 49.20 chains to the beginning
Chestnut 3x. containing 90 acres more or less, bounded by lands of J. H.
Cleveland, A. Allison and W. C. Goodwin. Together with all and sing-
