any wise concern. I S J Douthit Master of the County of
Greenville in the said State, send greeting: Whereas Robert H
Paris, Henry W Paris and John M Paris on or about
the 11th day of February in the year one thousand eight hundred
and seventy nine did exhibit their complaint in the Court
of Common Pleas in the County of Greenville and State
aforesaid, against Thomas H Paris, Moses J Paris, Jasper
Paris and James Lenhardt. And the cause being at issue before
the Honorable Court aforesaid, came on to be heard on the 21st
day of April One thousand eight hundred and seventy
nine, within the said Court, after a full hearing thereof,
and mature deliberation in the premises. Did order and adjus-
t and decree that the tract of land hereinafter mentioned
and described, should be sold at public auction, by S J
Douthit Master of Greenville County on the terms, and for
the purposes mentioned in said Court's order, as by reference
thereto, now file in the said Court will appear, and the said S
J Douthit Master, as aforesaid after having duly
advertised the said tract of land for twenty one days
for sale by public outcry, on the second day of June in the
year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and seventy
nine. Did then openly and publicly and according to the
custom of auction, sell and dispose of the said tract of land
below described, unto R G Williams for two thousand two
hundred and forty Dollars, the being at that price, the
highest bidder for the same. Now know all men that I
the said S J Douthit Master as aforesaid in consideration
of the premises, and also in consideration of the sum of Two
thousand two hundred and forty Dollars paid me by the said
R G Williams the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged.
I have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these pres-
ents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said R G
Williams and his heirs and assigns, all that tract of
land situate lying and being in the County of Greenville
and State aforesaid on branch waters of Saluda River

adjoining lands of S J Douthit, H C, a boundary of W Hornburg and
others, and containing two hundred and fourteen acres more or less
together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and
appurtenances whatsoever, to the said tract of land belonging, or in
anywise pertaining, and the revenues and remainders, rents, issues
and profits thereof, and also all the estate, right title interest, power
possession, property, benefit, claim and demand whatsoever, both at
law and in equity, of the said John Paris deceased and of all
the parties to the said suit and of all other persons rightfully claim-
ing, or to claim, the same, or any part thereof, by, from or under
them, or either of them. To have and to hold the said tract of land
with its hereditaments, privileges and appurtenances unto the said R
G Williams, his heirs and assigns forever.
