The State of South Carolina  
Whereas, on the eighteenth day of  
May AD 1874, Emma M Westfield  
and Whittier Symmes, Plaintiff,  
exhibited their complaint for Relief &c, in the Circuit Court of Greenville Plus,  
for the County of Greenville and State aforesaid, against Thomas Mc Cox  
Thomas Gowers, William Birnie and others, Defendants, wherein  
amongst other things it was alleged that one John Westfield, now  
deceased, on the day of AD 1873, sold and conveyed to the  
plaintiff, Whittier Symmes and Thomas Mc Cox and Thomas Gowers, the  
Defendants, and to one James Birnie, also now deceased, an undivided  
four (4-5) fifths interest in and to certain Real Estate, in and around  
the City of Greenville, in the County and State aforesaid, and more partic-  
ularly described in the deed of conveyance of that date; and on the  
30<sup>th</sup> day of September AD 1873, the said John Westfield, agreed to  
sell to the firm of Cox Birnie & Co, which was composed of himself  
and other parties last above-named certain other lots, pieces or  
parcels of land in and near the said City of Greenville, and County  
and State aforesaid, and were particularly described in said agree-  
ment; and that the said parties who were interested in the lands  
above mentioned, in order to facilitate the sale and transfer  
of said lands, had agreed to and amongst themselves, to convey  
all of the said lands in trust, to two of their number to sell  
and divide the proceeds of sale amongst the parties, accord-  
ing to their respective interests; and prayed amongst other  
things that these matters might be enquired into, and if  
found advisable to carry out the said agreement in refer-  
ence to a trust deed, that a suitable trust deed be repre-  
ted, together with some suitable person or persons to act as trus-  
tee or trustees; and whereas, upon the said cause being heard,  
on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of June AD 1874, it was referred to a special  
Referee, to report on the various matters embraced in the ple-  
adings in said cause, and upon the report of said special referee  
coming in, containing the various recommendations therein  
more fully set forth, it was on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of August AD 1874,  
amongst other things, ordered that Whittier Symmes and  
Thomas Gowers, be appointed Trustees, to whom William  
A. Mc Daniel, Clerk of the said Court, should convey the said  
lands, to have and to hold the same, to, for and upon the  
purposes uses and trusts, as set forth and declared in the Deeds  
reported by the said referee; and whereas, the said William  
A. Mc Daniel, Clerk as aforesaid did convey the lands  
mentioned in the pleadings to the said Trustees: Now  
therefore Know all men by these presents, that we, Thomas  
Gowers and Whittier Symmes, Trustees as aforesaid, by  
virtue of the power conferred upon us in and by the order  
and trust deed aforesaid, upon the written request of  
the parties give trust and in performance of our duty

as such Trustees and also in consideration of the sum of Four Hund-  
red and eighty five Dollars, to us paid by Thomas Mc Cox before  
the delivery of these presents, have granted bargained sold and released,  
and by these presents, do grant bargain sell and release unto the said  
Thomas Mc Cox all that piece parcel or lot of land being parcels of  
the lands above mentioned - situate and lying in the City of Green-  
ville, in the County and State aforesaid commencing at a Stake on Street  
running thence N 4<sup>o</sup> W fifty feet to stake, running thence N 85<sup>1/2</sup> E  
one hundred and twenty feet to stake on street, running thence S 4<sup>o</sup> E  
65<sup>1/2</sup> feet to stake on street thence along street S 85<sup>1/2</sup> W one  
hundred and twenty feet to the beginning corner and known in  
Plat of Dickson Surveyor dated 2<sup>nd</sup> July AD 1878 as lot No five - also  
that other parcel or lot of land commencing at a stake on street run-  
ning thence S 4<sup>o</sup> E fifty feet to a stake thence N 85<sup>1/2</sup> E one hundred and  
twelve feet to stake on street thence N 4<sup>o</sup> W fifty feet to stake on  
street, thence S 85<sup>1/2</sup> W one hundred and twenty feet to the beginning  
corner and known in Dickson Survey as lot No four - also that  
other parcel or lot of land commencing at a stake on corner of  
No four running thence S 4<sup>o</sup> E fifty feet to stake on no two  
thence N 85<sup>1/2</sup> E one hundred and twenty feet to stake on street  
thence N 4<sup>o</sup> W fifty feet to stake on no four thence S 85<sup>1/2</sup> W one  
hundred and twenty feet to the beginning corner and known in  
Dickson Survey as lot No three - also that other parcel in  
same City and State beginning at a stake on street running thence S 4<sup>o</sup>  
E one hundred feet to a stake on lot no eighteen, thence N 85<sup>1/2</sup> E one hundred  
and fifty feet to a stake on street, thence N 4<sup>o</sup> W one hundred feet to stake  
on street, thence along street S 85<sup>1/2</sup> W one hundred and fifty feet to the begin-  
ning corner and known in Dickson Survey as lot No seventeen - also  
that other parcel or lot beginning at a stake on street running thence  
N 4<sup>o</sup> W one hundred feet to stake on lot no thirteen, thence N 85<sup>1/2</sup> E  
one hundred and fifteen feet to stake on street thence S 4<sup>o</sup> E one  
hundred feet to stake on street thence along street S 85<sup>1/2</sup> W one  
hundred and fifty feet to the beginning and known in Dickson  
Survey as lot No fourteen. Together with all and singular the  
rights members hereditaments and appurtenances, to the said  
premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining  
to have and to hold, all and singular the premises before men-  
tioned, unto the said Thomas Mc Cox his heirs and assigns,  
forever freed from and discharged of all further trusts  
whatever, and we do hereby bind ourselves, our heirs execu-  
tors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all  
and singular the said premises unto the said Thomas Mc Cox  
his heirs and assigns against us and our heirs and every  
other person, whomever lawfully claiming, or to claim the  
same or any part thereof, by, through and under us, as trustees  
aforesaid.
