tract of land purchased by me from W. A. Henderson, and this
conveyance is subject to a mortgage given by me to the
said Henderson for balance of purchase money, also one
Saddle horse, one cow and calf, one heifer, one sow and
pigs, all my household & kitchen furniture, and my entire
crop, consisting of cotton, corn, fodder and so forth
Togethr with all and singular the rights, members, heredit-
aments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging,
or in anywise incident or appertaining. To have and to
hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto
the said M. A. Smith her heirs and assigns forever, and
I do hereby bind myself and my heirs, executors and admin-
istrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular
the said premises unto the said M. A. Smith, her heirs
and assigns, against me and my heirs and every other
person lawfully claiming, or to claim the same, or any
part thereof.

hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold and released,
and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto
the said Mrs. L. B. Shelton all that piece parcel or tract of
land situated in the County of Greenville and State aforesaid,
adjoining lands of myself, Marshall Shelton, and the estate of
L. J. Luch and has the following metes and bounds: Beginning at a
stone 3 x 0.75 in Road and running thence S 36 W 2.04 to a stone
3 x 0.75, thence S 66 1/4 W 3.45 to a stone 3 x 0.75 thence S 60 1/4 W
4.80 to a stone 3 x 0.75, thence S 56 1/4 W 2.14 to a stone 3 x 0.75
