State aforesaid in consideration of twenty two Dollars to me paid by Moses Jimison of Greenville County in the State aforesaid, have granted bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents, do grant bargain, sell and release unto the said Moses Jimison all that piece parcel and lot of land containing two acres more or less, situate lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, three miles from Greenville Court House, on waters of Saluda River, being the Western part of the tract conveyed to me by Thomas Kehles or adjoining lands of Mauldin and said Kehles. Beginning at a stone 3 x 4 m on Mauldin's line and running thence S 71 1/2 E 3.88 c to a stone 3 x 4 m thence N 26 W 8.42 c to a stone 3 x 4 m on a branch, thence down the meanders of said branch as a line to a stone 3 x 4 m on South bank of the branch, thence S 6 1/8 E 8.18 c to the beginning. Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in any wise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Moses Jimison and his heirs and assigns forever.
