have granted bargained sold and released and by these  
presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said  
Moses Jinson all that piece (parcel) and lot of land contain-  
ing two acres more or less, situate lying and being  
in the County and State aforesaid, three miles from Greenv-  
ille Court House, on waters of Saluda River, being the  
Western part of the tract conveyed to me by Thomas Lile  
by adjoining lands of Mauldin and said Lile's.  
Beginning at a stone 3 x n m on Mauldin's line and running  
thence S 7 1/2 E 3.88 c to a stone 3 x n m thence N 26 W 8.42 c  
to a stone 3 x n m on a branch, thence down the meanders  
of said branch as a line to a stone 3 x n m on south bank of  
the branch, thence S 6 1/2 E 8.18 c to the beginning. Together  
with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and  
appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in any
