Know all men by these presents that I Paul Jaffeux of the County of Greenville in the State

aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One hundred and fifty Dollars to me in hand paid and before the sealing of these presents, by Mary P. Jaffeux of said County in the State aforesaid, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Mary P. Jaffeux that tract of land lying in the State and County aforesaid, containing eleven and three fourth acres, be the same more or less, situated on the East side of the White Horse Road, about four and a half miles from the City of Greenville beginning at a stone on said Road and running thence N 56° E 11° 60' chs to a stone 3 x 3 on on McLanahan and Cleveland old line. Thence with said line N 42° 1/4 W 11.95 chs to a stake 3 x 3 on on thence S 56° W 5.00 chs to a stone on said White Horse Road 3 x 3 on, thence along said road as a line to the beginning corner and joining lands of Samuel McLanahan deceased and A. L. Cobb, this being the same tract of land conveyed to me by John Ferguson and J. P. Miller, by Deed dated the second day of September AD 1879 and Recorded in office of Register of Meuse conveyance Book J. Page 718. Recorded 22nd October 1879. Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said Mary P. Jaffeux her heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby binds myself my heirs executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Mary P. Jaffeux and her heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and all other lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
