said J. Abner Nash do grant and release to the said  
Matthew P. Nash and Leander M. Nash and their heirs  
forever, all that tract of land situated in said County  
on South Rabun Creek, together with the mill shoal  
adjoining lands of James Nash, Young Nash and others  
containing twenty five acres, Together with all and  
singular the rights members hereditaments, and appur-  
tenances to the same belonging or in anywise incident  
or appertaining, To have and to hold all and singular  
the premises above mentioned unto the said Matthew P.  
Nash and Leander M. Nash their heirs and assigns forever  
and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and  
administrators to warrant and forever defend all  
and singular the said premises unto the said Matthew P.  
Nash and Leander M. Nash their heirs and assigns  
against myself and my heirs.
