Carter's line, thence S 35 1/3 W 23.13 to a Post Oak 3x3x on W. Carter's line, thence S 5 1/2 W 14.75 to a stake 3x3x in the creek, thence down the meanders of the creek as a line 27.66 to the beginning Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining: To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Emily C Howell her heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors, and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Emily C Howell her heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and all other persons whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
