Golightly, a certain piece parcel or tract of land containing three acres (3) be the same more or less, situate in Butler Township in Greenville County and State aforesaid, on the North side of Greenville & Spartanburg Road, beginning at a stone 8 x 6 m. on North side of said Road, thence S 28 1/4 W 5.13 ch. to a stone by R O stump 8 x 6 m thence N 45 W 6.00 ch 3 x 7 m thence N 28 1/4 E 5.13 ch 8 x 7 m thence S 45 E to the beginning corner I consideration of the sum of forty four dollars secured by a mortgage given for the second piece or parcel or tract of land containing four acres 1/4 quarter 28. Acres be the same more or less situate in Butler Township Greenville County, State aforesaid joining lot No. 1 beginning at a stone 8 x 7 m thence N 13 E 5.50 ch to a stone 8 x 7 m thence S 45 E 9.45 ch to lot No. 1 8 x thence S 28 1/4 W 5.13 ch 8 x thence N 45 W 7.85 ch to the beginning corner. Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.
