The State of South Carolina Know all men by these presents, that I N. A. Hoell of Greenville County in

the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty Dollars to me paid by Jesse W. Cannon of Greenville County in the State aforesaid, have granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Jesse W. Cannon a certain lot or parcel of land situate in the town of Green in Greenville County and State aforesaid. Beginning at a stone near the cross of the Mosteller an Chick Spring Roads and running S 37 1/2 W 200 feet to a stone thence S 59 E 100 feet to a stone thence N 37 1/2 E 200 feet to a stone thence N 59 W 100 feet to the beginning containing nineteen thousand nine hundred square feet (19900) or nearly one half acre more or less. Together with all and singular the rights members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining; To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Jesse W. Cannon his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors, and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Jesse W. Cannon his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs, and against every other person or persons whatsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim the same or any part thereof.

State of South Carolina Greenville District Know all men by these presents that I William

Cox of Greenville District and State aforesaid, for and in consideration of a mutual agreement between myself and John H. Goodwin of the District and State aforesaid, have agreed to run a line as follows, viz: Beginning at a sycamore 37x48 at the head of a ditch on North Saluda River and run N 60 W 45.5 to a stone in the old channel of said River thence S 40 3/4 W 42.5 to a stone in the old channel of said River thence S 10 W 1.55 to the centre of a creek and whereas the old channel of North Saluda River originally lies between my land and the land belonging to the said John H. Goodwin I hereby relinquish all right claim or interest to any part that my paper may cover, between the above described lines and the old channel of the River to the said John H. Goodwin, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the above described land unto the said John H. Goodwin his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every other person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
