Bossett in the State aforesaid, have granted bargain sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release, unto the said Mrs L. M. Bossett all that lot or parcel of land lying and being within the corporate limits of the City of Greenville in the State of South Carolina, situate on the Laurens and Spartanburg road about one mile from the City commencing at a stone on the side walk near the bridge on Richland creek and running thence

on the North side of said Laurens & Spartanburg Road, thence No. 14 1/2 W 66 feet to a stake at the water edge on Richland creek, thence down the meanders of said creek to a stake on the water edge, thence So. 31 W 20 feet to stake, thence So. 89 W 97 feet to the beginning surrounded on three sides by lands of said Emmala & Elizabeth Jones and one side by said Laurens & Spartanburg Street and containing about four thousand square feet more or less all which will more fully appear by reference to accompanying Plat.
