sold released and by these presents do grant bargain sell
and release unto the said J. H. Boyd and William P. Taylor (deacons
of the aforesaid Baptist Church) and their successors in
office, a lot of land situate in Greenville County and State aforesaid
on a head branch of Wards creek South of Green River in the
Town of Greer, beginning at a stone on Cannon street and
running thence S 74 E 25 4 to a stone on said street
thence N 89 W 2 75 to a stone on said street thence with said
street S 30 W 5 20 to the beginning containing one acre one
rod and twenty perches or more or less. Together with all
and singular the rights, incidents, hereditaments and appurtenances
to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appur-
taining. To have and to hold all and singular the rights
premises before mentioned unto the said J. H. Boyd and
William P. Taylor, Deacons and their successors in office
forever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs, executors
and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all
and singular the said premises unto the said J. H. Boyd and
William P. Taylor, Deacons and their successors in office
against me and my heirs, and against every other person or
persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same,
or any part thereof.
