Hudson of all other the decrees herein made and the power and authority in me therein vested, and also in consideration of the sum of two million three hundred and unity three thousand and six hundred dollars to me paid by the said William A. Courtenay, William P. Clyde, Joseph Bryan and J. M. Logan have granted, bargained, sold, released, set over and assigned and delivered and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, release, set over, assign, and deliver to the said William A. Courtenay, William P. Clyde, Joseph Bryan and J. M. Logan their heirs and assigns forever, all the following described and enumerated real and personal property, franchises, corporate rights & privileges, estate, property, funds, that is to say: the entire property and estate, franchises, corporate rights and privileges, real estate and personal property of the Greenville and Columbia Rail Road Company, being the entire Rail Road of said Company running from Columbia to Greenville and to Anderson and to Abbeville in said State, including the bed and superstructure of said Rail Road and the materials used in the construction thereof as the same was owned, operated and used on the 29<sup>th</sup> day of Nov. 1879, including all railway branches, ways, rights of way, depot grounds and all lands in any manner belonging to or connected with said line of railway and all tracks, rails, bridges, viaducts, station-houses, depots, ware-houses, engine-houses, car-houses, freight-houses, sheds, wood-houses and other structures and buildings and all machine shops and other shops then the property of the said Corporation including all locomotives, steam engines, tenders, coaches, cars, and other rolling stock and equipment and stationary engines, machinery, tools, implements, fuel materials for constructing, operating, repairing and replacing the railroad aforesaid or any part thereof or any of the equipments or appurtenances of the said Rail Road in any part thereof also all the machinery of all kinds in the shops of the said Corporation

iron and irons, castings, bellows, tools and materials of all kinds and all and singular the personal property of every nature, kind and description then belonging to the said Corporation and also all the right, title and interest of the said Rail Road Company in the Blue Ridge Rail Road together with all claims, demands, lands, choses in action of any and every kind held by said Rail Road Company against the Blue Ridge Rail Road Company and also all other estate and property, real & personal, rights, privileges and franchises whatsoever to the said Corporation belonging on the said 29<sup>th</sup> day of November 1879 together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said line of railway, the lands and premises aforesaid or either of them, belonging, or in any wise appertaining and the reversions, remainders, tolls, incomes, rents, reverses, issues and profits thereof and all the estate, right, title, interest, property, possession, claim and demand whatsoever as well at law as in equity of the said Corporation in and to the same and every part thereof with the appurtenances. And it is hereby declared to be the true intent and purpose of these presents to convey and transfer to the said William A. Courtenay, William P. Clyde, Joseph Bryan and J. M. Logan all the estate and property real and personal of every character and description and all the rights, privileges and franchises of the said Corporation which were directed and decreed to be sold by the said decrees above mentioned and which were sold accordingly by the said Master whither the same be herein specially mentioned or not. To have and to hold the premises and every part thereof as herein before set forth and described unto the said William A. Courtenay, William P. Clyde, Joseph Bryan and J. M. Logan; to them, their heirs and assigns forever.
