by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the  
said William Goldsmith all that piece parcel or lot of land

the City of Greenville the same being two lots to wit the  
first Beginning in forks of the Laurens and Lowndes  
Hills roads at a stone thence S 71° E 22.50 to a bend in the  
road thence S 33 1/2° E 10 to a bend thence S 32 1/2° E 17 1/2 to a  
bend thence S 51 1/2° E 68 to a Post Oak corner thence N 13  
E 50 to a rock thence S 72 W 3 to a bend thence S 79 W 47 20  
to beginning corner and said to contain one hundred  
and two and seven tenths acres more or less  
Also the Grant place known as lot No 15 commencing  
at stone on Lowndes Hill Road running S 26 1/2° E 37.10 to  
a stone thence N 62° E 11.80 to a stone thence N 25 1/2° W 35.20  
to a stone on said road S 79 W 3.70 to beginning corner  
and said to contain forty five acres more or less  
Together with all and singular the rights members heredita-  
ments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging  
or in anywise incident or appertaining to have and to  
hold all and singular the said premises before mentioned  
unto the said William Goldsmith his heirs and assigns  
forever And we do hereby bind ourselves our heirs  
executors and administrators to warrant and forever  
defend all and singular the said premises unto the said  
William Goldsmith his heirs and assigns against us  
and our heirs and every other person in whomsoever  
lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part  
thereof
