 jacent the Lake Roberts Spring for the term of three years  
 on terms of making and gathering crops for the  
 specific sum of Twenty Dollars of good minding and  
lockers weighing four hundred lbs each for Rent  
 of said land. Four Dollars to be paid on or before the  
 first day of October A. D. 1881 of the above named con-  
 tract. Four Dollars to be paid on or before the first day  
 of October A. D. 1882. Four Dollars to be paid on or  
 before the first day of October 1883. The said party  
 of the second part agrees to and with the said party  
 of the first part to Rent from him the above described  
 tract of land as above set forth and pay to the said  
 William C. Corley party of the first part Seven  
Dollars of good minding and lockers weighing four  
hundred lbs each to be paid on the above described  
 payments for Rent and if further agreement  
 part of the crop or crops shall be made away  
 with by fire or otherwise until the Rent is paid  
 as above stated and no timber to be carried  
 from the place and all hillsides ditch to be  
 cut where needed he is to clear any land and  
 place except at the back of my house Walden  
house and rent to Mr. A. B. Lane - Walden
