to a stone 3x6 thence W 10° W 25.71 to a stone 3x6 in branch N 20° E 8.36 to a stone 3x6 or W. O gone thence N 39° W 10.00 across Gilders Creek to the beginning corner and having such marks buildings and boundaries as is represented in a plat hereto attached made by J K Dickson D. S. and bearing date 17<sup>th</sup> May AD 1877 containing two hundred and twenty acres being a part of the tract of Josiah Kilgore deceased Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said E O Hughes his heirs and assigns forever.
