day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty one between William A. M. Daniel Esquire, Clerk of the Honorable Circuit Court for Greenville County, at Greenville Court House in the said State, of the one part, and James A. M. Daniel of the other part, whereas J. O. L. Blumig on or about the 26th day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy eight exhibited his Bill of Complaint in the Circuit Court, at Greenville Court House in the said State, against W. A. Hudson and Rosaline Hudson for the foreclosure of a mortgage, and the cause, being at issue before the Honorable Court, came out to be heard at March Term, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty one the said Court after full hearing thereof and mature deliberation, in the premises did order, adjudge, and decree, that the premises described in the complaint, should be sold at public Auction, by the Clerk of the said Court, on the terms and for the purposes mentioned in their decretal order, as by reference thereto in the Registry of the said Court will appear; and the said William A. M. Daniel Esquire as Clerk of the said Court, after having duly advertised the said premises twenty one days for sale, by public outcry, on the 7th day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty one did then, openly and publicly, and according to the custom of auctioneers sell and dispose of the said premises below described, unto the said James A. M. Daniel for Eight hundred and fifty six Dollars being at that price the highest for the same. Now therefore this indenture was made that the said Court should adjudge

Esquire, as Clerk of the said Court, under and by virtue of the said decree, and in consideration of the sum of Eight hundred and fifty six Dollars paid him by the said James A. M. Daniel the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath granted bargained, sold, released, and by these presents doth grant bargain, sell, and release unto the said James A. M. Daniel his heirs and assigns, all those two lots or parcels of land situate lying and being in the City of Greenville County and State of said, described as follows, to wit: (1) one lot fronting One hundred and thirty two (132) feet on Washington St and a depth of one hundred and sixty five (65) feet adjoining lot of Murray & others, containing one half acre more or less, also the lot adjoining the above described lot and fronting on John Street one hundred and thirty two (132) feet with a depth of one hundred and sixty five (65) feet, containing one (1/2) half acre more or less. Together with all and singular the hereditaments, rights, members and appurtenances whatsoever, to the said premises belonging, or in any wise appertaining, and the reversions and remainders, rents, issues and profits thereof, and also all the estate, right, title, interest, dower, possession, property, benefit, claim, and demand whatsoever, both at law and in equity of the heirs and representatives of the said W. A. Hudson or Rosaline Hudson and of the parties to this suit, and of all other persons rightfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof, by, from or under them, or either of them, to have and to hold the said premises with its hereditaments, privileges and appurtenances unto the said James A.
