ed bargained sold and released and by these  
presents do grant bargain sell and release unto  
the said Mary O. Pressley, all that piece parcel and  
tract of land situate lying and being in Greenville  
County, State aforesaid, crossing the line into the  
State of North Carolina, in the branch waters of  
South Saluda River, containing one thousand Acres  
more or less being the same tract of land granted  
to Samuel Caine & Gabriel Benson on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of  
September 1809 Together with all and singular the  
rights members hereditaments and appurtenances  
to the said premises belonging, or in anywise  
incident or appertaining. To have and to hold,  
all and singular the premises before mentioned  
unto the said Mary O. Pressley her heirs and  
assigns forever, and we do hereby bind oursel-  
ves and our heirs executors and administrators  
to warrant and forever defend all and singular  
the said premises unto the said Mary O. Pressley  
her heirs and assigns against us and our heirs  
lawfully claiming, or to claim the same, or any  
part thereof.
