Carver of the County of Greenville in the State of South Carolina for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty Dollars to me paid by Noah Cannon of the County of Greenville in the State of South Carolina have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Noah Cannon all that certain portion or parcel of land situated being and lying in the aforesaid State and County in the Town of Green Station and known as a part of lot No 22 on a map of the several lots and streets of said Town made by Jas. K. Dickson on April 1880 Beginning at the corner on Mill Street between lots No 21 & 22 and running thence with the line between the two said lots to the back line of lot No 8 N 7 1/2 E thence with the line between lots No 8 and 22 S 12 1/2 E 75 links to a stake thence S 7 1/2 W to a stake on Mill Street thence with said Street N 12 1/2 W 75 links to the beginning corner containing one Rod and four Poles be the same more or less together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. Do have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Noah Cannon his heirs and assigns forever.
