 Thirteen hundred and fifty eight dollars to us  
 paid by E H Peden and J P Peden of Greenville  
 County in the State aforesaid, have granted bargained  
 and sold, and released, and by these presents do  
 grant bargain sell and release unto the said E H Peden  
 and J P Peden all that piece of land or tract of  
 land situate and being in the County and State  
 aforesaid, and lying on Head Waters of South  
 Rabun Creek Waters of Reedy River bounded  
 by lands of W A Dailey, Jas H Peden, D C Tally  
 D M Peden and others Beginning at a white  
 Oak 3x at the Old Academy lot thence S 84 E  
 13.00 to state 3x thence N 76 1/2 E 7.50 to a white  
 Oak 3x thence S 11 1/2 E 1.70 to a Willow 3x on the  
 Academy Branch, thence down the meander  
 of said branch to a stone 3x on Mile Yaptetous  
 line thence S 2 1/2 E 2.50 to a stone 3x thence S 34  
 W 21.31 to a history, thence N 65 W 8.40 to a  
 Red Oak 3x thence N 75 W 34.63 to a stake  
 3x on Ridge Road thence S 78 1/2 W 5.43 to a  
 P O Rock 3x on Neely Ferry Road, thence in
