Cook all that piece parcel and tract of land containing forty seven acres more or less, situate lying and being in Greenville County in the State aforesaid five miles west of Greenville Court House on Saluda River adjoining lands of L. W. Watson, Sr. paid Cook and myself, and having the following metes and bounds viz Beginning at a stone 3x6 in place of a Chinquapin oak on the River and running thence N 78 1/2 E 8.50 to a Black Oak 18x6 cm thence N 53 E 9.50 to a stone 3x6 in on the old line, thence N 48 W 19.50 to a stone 3x6 in on said Cook's line thence S 29 W 8.50 to a willow 3x6 in on the River thence with the various meanderings of the River as a line to the beginning.
