 C. Kilgore and L. C. Kilgore filed their petition on the
 18th day of December 1876 against B. F. Kilgore and resid-
 uary Kilgore for the partition of the Real Estate of said
 Kilgore deceased in the Probate Court for said County
 among said parties according to their respective shares
 and whereon on the 16th day of April A. D. 1877, the same
 ordered and approved by S. J. Douthett Probate Judge for
 said County that the tract of 879 acres situated in
 Greenville County be partitioned amongst Wm. H. Stokes
 Wm. H. J. Hunter and B. F. Kilgore in the proportions
 of two fifths to Wm. Stokes two fifths to Wm. Hunter
 and one fifth to B. F. Kilgore and whereas on the
 4th day of May A. D. 1877 a writ of Partition for the
 purpose aforesaid was issued out of the Probate
 Court for said County directed to James M. Dickson
 Daniel Dasher and S. H. White Commissioners and
 whereas the said Commissioners did go upon said
 tract of land in obedience to said writ of parti-
 tion and on the 17th day of May 1877 allotted to Wm. H. J.
 Hunter Three Hundred and Fifty acres of said
 tract of land and valued by said Commissioners
 at Twenty four Hundred and fifty dollars which
 said tract of 350 acres said Commissioners assigned
 to said Wm. Hunter as his two fifths under the
 decree aforesaid and designated the same by a
 plat accompanying their return wherein the same
 was returned approved and confirmed by me
 S. J. Douthett as Probate Judge on the 18th day

of May 1877 now therefore have all men by these presents

 by Wm. H. J. Hunter of Spartanburg County has granted, con-
 quitted even and released and by these presents do grant bargain
 sell and release unto the said Wm. H. J. Hunter all that
 certain tract and parcel of land situated lying and being
 in the County of Greenville and State aforesaid on the
 one Petera Leake beginning at a stake 3+ n. on branch
 thence S 20° W 17.00 to a stake 3+ n. thence S 15° W 75.75 to a
 stake 3+ n. thence N 68° W 42.83 to a stake 3+ n. in hedge now thence
 N 39° W 34.19 to a stake 3+ n. thence N 20° W 41.43 to a stake
 3+ n. thence N 21° W 39.73 to a stake 3+ n. thence 3+ n. on said
 branch thence N 41° said branch 20 chains to the beginning
 corner and containing Three Hundred and fifty acres
 more or less - Together with all and singular the Rights
